The session also focused on preventive measures, coping strategies, and the importance of seeking professional help before the situation escalates. The event was primarily targeted at female students, acknowledging the unique mental health challenges that young women often face. The session addressed common issues like academic stress, social pressures, emotional well-being, and self-esteem, while also highlighting the need for open conversations about mental health in the community.

**Objectives:**

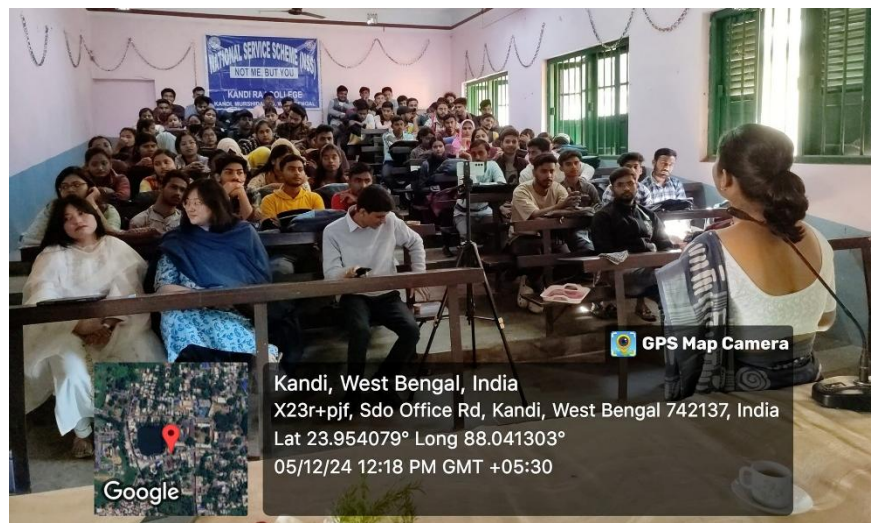
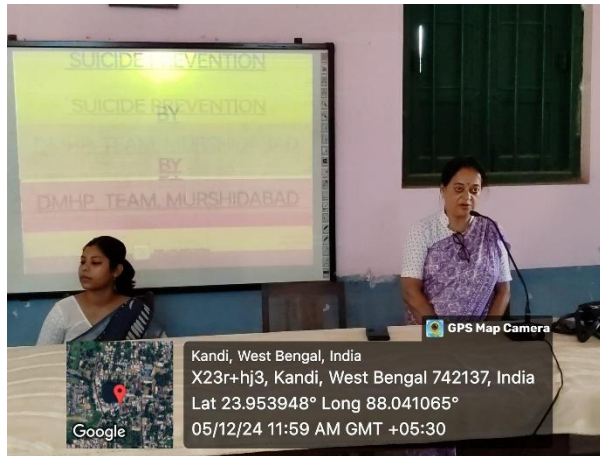

To raise awareness among students, teachers, and the community about the importance of human rights and their role in promoting social justice, equality, and dignity for all individuals.

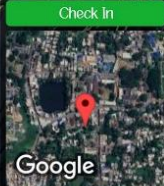
### **Conclusion**

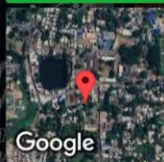






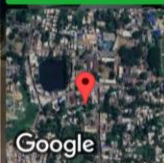

4. To provide a platform for students to showcase their talents and creativity.

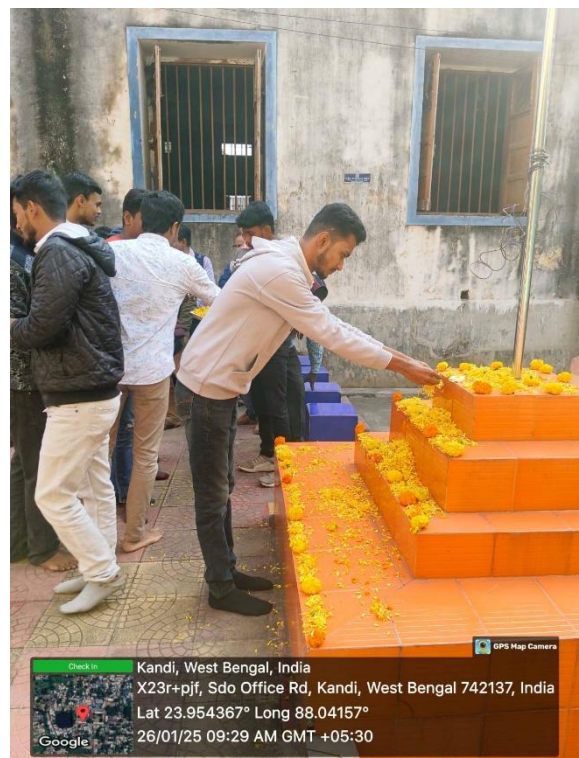
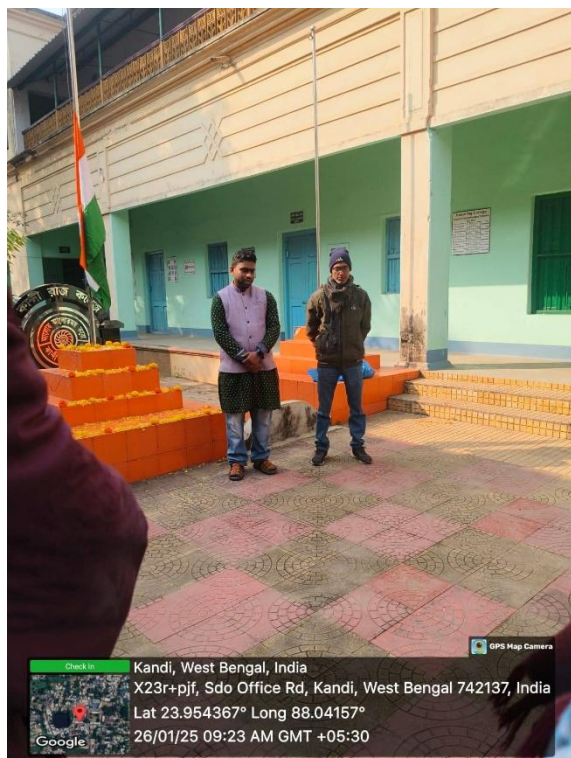
**Conclusion**
